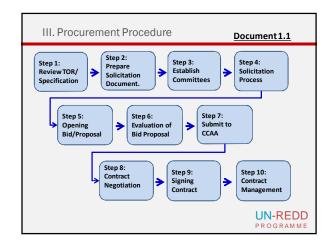

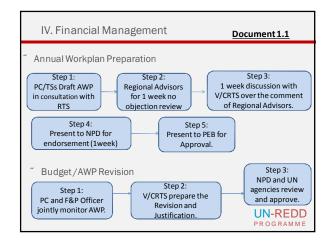

Organizing Workshop/Meeting/Training required concept note, proposed budget approved by Chair and Vice Chair of RTS.

There is agreement produced for activities undertaken by line agencies such as FA, FiA, GDANCP and still follow RTS policy of expense.

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III. Procurement Procedure Document 1.1 Procurement plan has to be approved at beginning of each year. Procurement can be done directly by UN-Agencies if there is request, or the Programme can make direct appointment by using Long Term Agreement (LTA) of UN-Agencies. 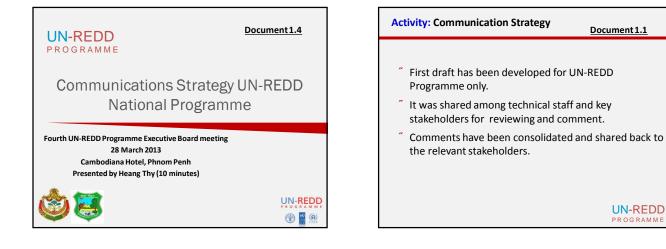


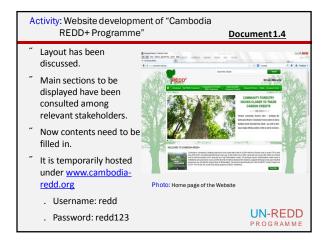

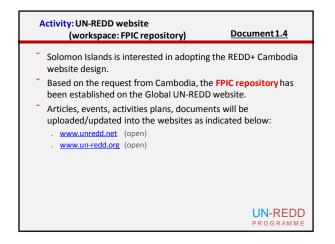
