<p>Brief guideline on MRV/REL by Mr. Shigeru Ono</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Mr. Shigeru Ono: presented about a “brief guideline on MRV/REL.” He pointed out the need of developing national GHGs inventory to be submitted to the UNFCCC. This requires at least the information data about land use, drivers of forest degradation, and land classification changes. The deadline to submit to UNFCCC is December 2014. In addition, Shigeru Ono also offered a talk about the MRV/REL work plan in order speed up the discussion on MRV work plan. Meanwhile, the MRV TT requested for including the draft MRV/REL work plan with the outcomes of work plan activities which were mentioning through the last two meetings. - The MRV TT discussed about the administrative system of the MRV TT and the team has requested the following items to the UNREDD should have: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o A clear agenda will be distributed to all participants prior to the start of the meeting o Materials and document to be distributed including document, notebooks, pens. o Communication service fee for meeting invitation - Ono and Sakai: shared experiences of the model of national forest inventory system in Congo. - Mathieu: also showed the test national forest system web platform of

	Cambodia which was prepared by FAO to all MRV TT members.
Discussion	<p>The MRV TT members kicked off the discussion on MRV work plan and the following items are the result:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Outcome 4.4 and 4.5 and its activity details. The activity 4.4.6 (identify the content for data development in database) to be discussion finally in the next meeting because it needs to wait for the discussion with the representatives from MoE and FiA up on this request. ○ Document on administrative work system of MRV requires REDD+ secretariat team to become the responsible team meaning REDD+ secretariat team should arrange all MRV meetings (venue, document, and agenda items plus the minute reports). ○ Agreement to have a series of presentations of different experiences, forest inventory of NGOs, FA, MoE, FiA in order to find out the joint agreement on the shape of plot sampling for the national forest inventory. ○ MRV TT agreed to have the next MRV meeting on March 4, 2014 under the aim of discussing about the guideline on national forest inventory (NFI), the minute report(s) will be submitted to FA simultaneously and accordingly.
