Objectives:

- Promoting stakeholder engagement;
- Developing participatory monitoring protocols;
- Developing locally appropriate forest management interventions (policies and measures).



The Demonstrations Technical Team undertakes work on Policies and Measures on REDD+.

Beneficiaries: The programme builds capacities of government agencies and non-governmental stakeholders.

meetings to date, to
assist in the
identification of policies
and measures for

Lessons Learned/Achievements:

- It is essential to understand the drivers of deforestation and forest degradation clearly in order to design effective policies and measures
- Drivers vary by forest type and by location, so it cannot be assumed that interventions which work well in one area will work as well in other areas
- Bottom-up planning is required to ensure stakeholder engagement in designing policies and measures

Challenges: Clarifying policies and measures applicable at the local, sub-national and national scales in order to reduce emissions effectively and sustainably.
