## **Project Highlights**

CAM-REDD is one of supporting frameworks (e.g. UN-REDD, FCPF) to implement the multi-year work plan of the Cambodia REDD+ Taskforce. CAM-REDD was officially endorsed by the authorities representing the Royal Government of Cambodia, Forestry Administration, and Government of Japan, Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) on May 27, 2011.

CAM-REDD has been assisting various initiatives in the REDD+ readiness stage of multi-year work plan described in current four outcomes.
